Carreón-Robledo, an internationally acclaimed conductor known for his dynamic work in opera, ballet, and symphony, joins OBT from Tulsa Ballet, where he served as Resident Conductor for four seasons. He made a memorable debut with OBT as a guest conductor in 2023, conducting *La Sylphide* and returning for *Swan Lake* the following season. His deep connection with musicians and artists alike, combined with his vibrant energy and artistic passion, made him the clear choice after a thorough search that included valuable feedback from orchestra members and company leaders.

Sarah Tiedemann, OBT Orchestra Committee Co-Chair, shared, "The official appointment of only the second Music Director in OBT's history is truly a momentous occasion. Maestro Carreón-Robledo's artistic passion, skill, and chemistry with the orchestra were clear from the first moment he took the podium. We're thrilled to be entering this new era under his leadership and look forward to bringing wonderful music to our audiences for years to come!"

His unique ability has earned him critical acclaim across the globe.
